FISHWORKS LOCATION ANNOUNCED!

After two years of working on the overgrown, narrow reaches of our headwater streams, Area Fish Manager Marty Engel has come up with a sensational, new project. In exploring a chunk of land that the DNR owns, Marty discovered a stretch of river that's virtually unknown, let alone fished. This year's project is going to surprise you: It's on the Kinni, only a couple miles outside of River Falls. It's made up of meanders, deep pools, a few nice riffles, decent weed growth, nice scenery and almost limitless potential. Wait until you see the slides at our January meeting! Unlike past projects, this stretch is wide enough so that Gary declared even he could get off a back cast. (I also caught him drooling). This stretch is part of our plan to eventually checkerboard the Kinni with improved sections. This strategy will provide a variety of habitats and help spread out the angling pressure.

We have access from only one bank, so this is the year quite a few of us will have to work in waders. Also new for this year is that Marty and Brian will be marking the stuff they want cut and will be treating the stumps almost immediately. 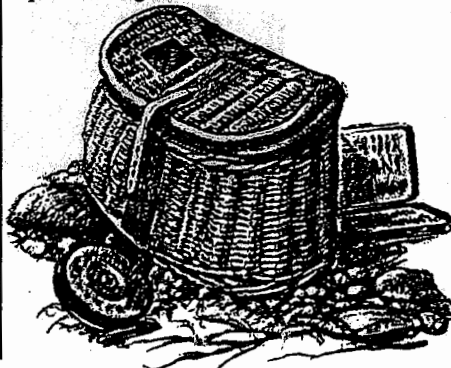

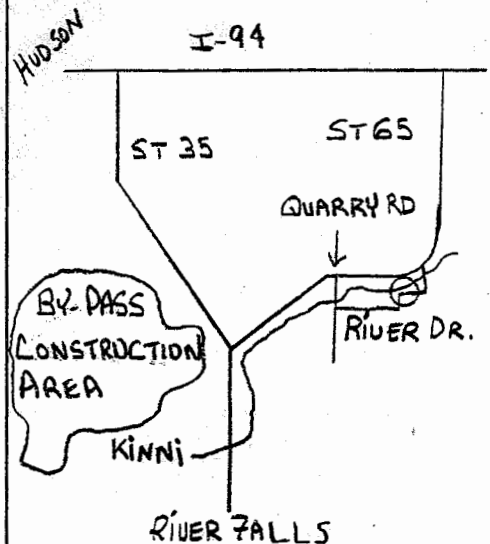
Special thanks also goes for all who donated to this year's event both with items for the silent auction and for purchasing items at the auction.

As in the past, bring warm clothes, coffee and lunch, saws, waders and a sense of humor. Remember that it's winter, so the KIAP-TU-WISH RULE OF 20 (that is, -20° Airtemp or windchill we will cancel) is in effect. Follow these directions or check out the map:

- **Take ST 35 south from I-94
- **Turn LEFT on ST 65 (just before the new ST35 Bridge over the Kinni)
- **Proceed approx. two (2) miles to Quarry Road
- **Turn RIGHT on Quarry Rd
- **Proceed approx. 3/4 mi. to River Dr.
- **Turn LEFT on River Dr. to work area

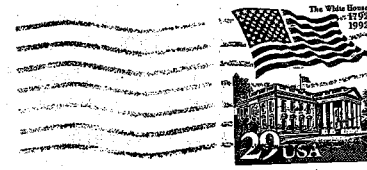
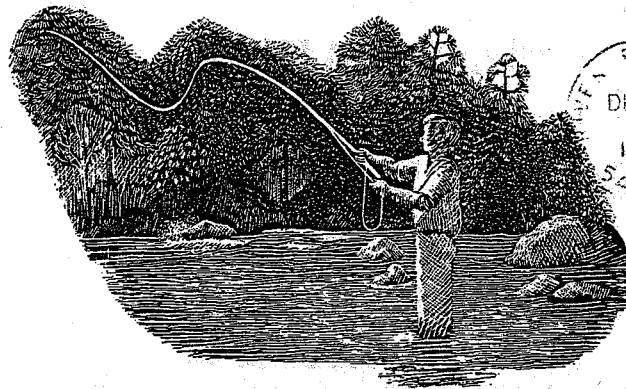
